- TWO CITIES: THE CITY OF MAN (EARTHLY, DRIVEN BY SELF-LOVE) AND THE CITY OF GOD (DIVINE LOVE).
- ROLE OF GOVERNMENT: EARTHLY RULERS SERVE A TEMPORAL PURPOSE; ULTIMATE AUTHORITY RESIDES WITH GOD.
- JUSTIFICATION OF AUTHORITY: AUTHORITY IS DIVINE, AND HUMAN RULERS MUST ALIGN WITH DIVINE LAW.
- LEGACY: AUGUSTINE'S THEOLOGICAL APPROACH INFLUENCED CHRISTIAN POLITICAL THOUGHT PROFOUNDLY.

THOMAS AQUINAS'S SUMMA THEOLOGICA

- TWO PRINCIPLES OF JUSTICE:
 1. EQUAL BASIC RIGHTS.
 2. SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC INEQUALITIES ARE ARRANGED TO BENEFIT THE LEAST ADVANTAGED.
- JUSTICE AS FAIRNESS: ENSURING EQUITABLE COOPERATION WITHIN SOCIETY.
