Factoring Formulas

Graphing and Functions

Solving Absolute Value Equations

$$|ax + b| = c \rightarrow ax + b = c \text{ or } ax + b = -c$$

- Solve both equations separately.
- Check for extraneous solutions, especially when dealing with inequalities.

Solving Inequalities

1. Perform the same operations on both sides.
2. Reverse inequality when multiplying or dividing by a negative.
3. Graph solutions on a number line or interval notation.

Functions and Their Properties

Understanding functions is key to algebraic reasoning and problem solving.

Function Notation

- $f(x)$ denotes the output of the function f at input x .
- Domain: set of all possible input values.
- Range: set of all possible output values.

Types of Functions

- Linear: $f(x) = mx + b$
- Quadratic: $f(x) = ax^2 + bx + c$
- Polynomial: sum of powers of x with coefficients
- Rational: ratio of two polynomials

- Swap x and y in the function equation and solve for y .
- Graph of the inverse is a reflection over $y = x$.

Logarithms and Exponentials

These are vital for solving equations involving growth, decay, and other real-world phenomena.

Logarithm Rules

- Product Rule: $\log_b(M N) = \log_b(M) + \log_b(N)$
- Quotient Rule: $\log_b(M / N) = \log_b(M) - \log_b(N)$
- Power Rule: $\log_b(M^k) = k \log_b(M)$
- Change of Base Formula: $\log_b(a) = \log(a) / \log(b)$

Exponential and Logarithmic Equations

1. Rewrite the equation in exponential or logarithmic form.
2. Use properties to isolate the variable.
3. Check for extraneous solutions, especially with logarithms (domain restrictions).

Sequences and Series

Sequences and series are common in algebra problems, especially for understanding patterns.

Arithmetic Sequences

- Common difference: d
- General term: $a_n = a_1 + (n - 1)d$
- Sum of first n terms: $S_n = n/2 (a_1 + a_n)$

Polynomial Functions

- Degree and Leading Coefficient:
- Degree determines end behavior.

- Zeroes of Polynomials:
- Roots where the polynomial equals zero.
- Multiplicity indicates repeated roots.
- Remainder and Factor Theorems:
- Remainder Theorem: $f(k)$ gives the remainder when dividing by $(x - k)$.
- Factor Theorem: $(x - k)$ is a factor if $f(k) = 0$.

Rational Expressions and Equations

- Simplify by factoring numerator and denominator.
- Find common denominators to add or subtract.
- Solve rational equations by multiplying through by the least common denominator (LCD), then solving.
- Remember to check for extraneous solutions after clearing denominators.

Radical Functions and Expressions

- Simplify radicals: $\sqrt{a \times b} = \sqrt{a} \times \sqrt{b}$.
- Rationalize denominators when necessary.
- Exponent rules:
- $\sqrt{a} = a^{(1/2)}$

- $(a^m)^n = a^{(m \times n)}$
- $a^m / a^n = a^{(m - n)}$
- Solve equations involving radicals by isolating the radical and then squaring both sides.

Exponential and Logarithmic Functions

- Exponential Functions: $y = a \times b^x$
- Growth if $b > 1$.
- Decay if $0 < b < 1$.
- Logarithmic Functions: $y = \log_b(x)$
- Inverse of exponential functions.
- Properties:
 - $\log_b(xy) = \log_b(x) + \log_b(y)$
 - $\log_b(x / y) = \log_b(x) - \log_b(y)$
 - $\log_b(b^x) = x$
- Change of Base Formula: $\log_b(a) = \log(a) / \log(b)$

Graphing and Analyzing Functions

Graphing is essential for visual understanding of algebraic concepts. Here's what to remember:

Linear Functions

- Slope-intercept form: $y = mx + b$
- Slope (m): rate of change

- Y-intercept (b): point where the line crosses the y-axis
- Graph: straight line through the y-intercept with slope m

Quadratic and Polynomial Graphs

- Parabolas: symmetric about the axis of symmetry
- Use vertex form for easy graphing
- Identify roots and intercepts to sketch the parabola

Rational Function Graphs

- Asymptotes:
- Vertical asymptotes: where denominator equals zero
- Horizontal asymptotes: compare degrees of numerator and denominator
- Oblique (slant) asymptotes: when degree of numerator is exactly one more than denominator
- Behavior near asymptotes guides the graph shape

Exponential and Logarithmic Graphs

- Exponential growth/decay curves
- Logarithmic functions: increasing slowly, passing through (1, 0)

Solving Equations and Inequalities

Solving Equations

- Linear Equations: Isolate the variable.
- Quadratic Equations: Factoring, quadratic formula, completing the square.
- Polynomial Equations: Factor and use the zero-product property.

Solving Inequalities

- Similar to equations but pay attention to the inequality direction.

 - Open circle for " $<$ " or " $>$ "
 - Closed circle for " $\leq$ " or " $\geq$ "
- Solve compound inequalities by splitting into separate parts.

Systems of Equations and Inequalities

Systems are multiple equations or inequalities solved simultaneously.

Linear Systems

- Methods:

1. Graphing: Find intersection point(s).
2. Substitution: Solve one equation for a variable, substitute into the other.
3. Elimination: Add or subtract equations to eliminate a variable.

- Solutions:

- One solution: intersecting lines.
- No solution: parallel lines.
- Infinite solutions: coincident lines.

Nonlinear Systems

- Combine linear equations with quadratics or other functions.
- Use substitution or elimination; sometimes graphing is helpful.

Sequences and Series

Sequences are ordered lists of numbers, and series are their sums.

Arithmetic Sequences

- Common difference: $d = a_{n+1} - a_n$
- nth term: $a_n = a_1 + (n - 1)d$

- Sum of first n terms: $S_n = (n/2)(a_1 + a_n)$

Geometric Sequences

- Common ratio: $r = a_{n+1} / a_n$
- n th term: $a_n = a_1 \times r^{n-1}$
- Sum of first n terms: $S_n = a_1(1 - r^n) / (1 - r)$, $r \neq 1$
- Infinite sum ($|r| < 1$): $S_\infty = a_1 / (1 - r)$
