UNDERSTANDING THE BASICS OF EKGs

WHAT IS AN EKG?

AN ELECTROCARDIOGRAM (EKG OR ECG) IS A NON-INVASIVE TEST THAT RECORDS THE ELECTRICAL ACTIVITY OF THE HEART OVER TIME. IT PROVIDES VITAL INFORMATION ABOUT HEART RHYTHM, CONDUCTION PATHWAYS, AND POTENTIAL STRUCTURAL OR ISCHEMIC ABNORMALITIES.

COMPONENTS OF AN EKG

AN EKG STRIP DISPLAYS SEVERAL KEY COMPONENTS:

- P WAVE: ATRIAL DEPOLARIZATION
- QRS COMPLEX: VENTRICULAR DEPOLARIZATION
- T WAVE: VENTRICULAR REPOLARIZATION
- U WAVE (SOMETIMES): PURKINJE FIBER REPOLARIZATION
- PR INTERVAL: TIME FROM ATRIAL DEPOLARIZATION TO VENTRICULAR DEPOLARIZATION
- QT INTERVAL: TOTAL TIME FOR VENTRICULAR DEPOLARIZATION AND REPOLARIZATION

STEP-BY-STEP APPROACH TO EKG INTERPRETATION

A SYSTEMATIC METHOD ENSURES ACCURACY AND CONSISTENCY. HERE'S A STRUCTURED APPROACH TO ANALYZING ANY ECG:

1. CONFIRM THE EKG QUALITY

- CHECK FOR PROPER CALIBRATION.
- ENSURE THE BASELINE IS STABLE.
- CONFIRM THE PAPER SPEED (USUALLY 25 MM/SEC).
- VERIFY THE VOLTAGE CALIBRATION (10 MM = 1 MV).

2. DETERMINE THE HEART RATE

METHODS TO CALCULATE HEART RATE INCLUDE:

- 300-150-100 METHOD: COUNT THE NUMBER OF LARGE SQUARES BETWEEN R WAVES AND DIVIDE ACCORDINGLY.
- COUNT R WAVES IN 6 SECONDS: COUNT THE R WAVES IN A 6-SECOND STRIP (30 LARGE SQUARES) AND MULTIPLY BY 10.
- USE A CALCULATOR OR APP FOR ACCURACY.

3. ASSESS THE RHYTHM

- REGULARITY: ARE THE R-R INTERVALS CONSISTENT?
- RHYTHM TYPE: SINUS RHYTHM, ATRIAL FIBRILLATION, VENTRICULAR TACHYCARDIA, ETC.
- IDENTIFY THE ORIGIN: IS THE RHYTHM ORIGINATING FROM THE SA NODE OR ELSEWHERE?

4. ANALYZE THE P WAVES

- PRESENCE AND MORPHOLOGY.
- CONSISTENCY IN SHAPE AND SIZE.
- RELATIONSHIP WITH QRS COMPLEXES (ONE P WAVE PER QRS INDICATES SINUS RHYTHM).

5. MEASURE THE PR INTERVAL

- NORMAL RANGE: 0.12-0.20 SECONDS (3-5 SMALL SQUARES).
- PROLONGED PR INTERVAL SUGGESTS FIRST-DEGREE AV BLOCK.
- SHORTENED PR INTERVAL MAY INDICATE PRE-EXCITATION SYNDROMES LIKE WOLFF-PARKINSON-WHITE.

6. EXAMINE THE QRS COMPLEX

- NORMAL DURATION: LESS THAN 0.12 SECONDS (3 SMALL SQUARES).
- WIDE QRS (>0.12 SEC): POSSIBLE BUNDLE BRANCH BLOCK OR VENTRICULAR ORIGIN.
- MORPHOLOGY: IDENTIFY ABNORMAL PATTERNS OR CONDUCTION DELAYS.

7. EVALUATE THE ST SEGMENT AND T WAVES

- ST SEGMENT: ISOELECTRIC LINE; ELEVATION OR DEPRESSION INDICATES ISCHEMIA OR INFARCTION.
- T WAVES: INVERSION OR ABNORMAL HEIGHT CAN SUGGEST ISCHEMIA, ELECTROLYTE IMBALANCE, OR REPOLARIZATION ISSUES.

8. MEASURE THE QT INTERVAL

- NORMAL QTc: <440 MS IN MEN, <460 MS IN WOMEN.
- PROLONGED QT CAN PREDISPOSE TO DANGEROUS ARRHYTHMIAS.

COMMON EKG ABNORMALITIES AND THEIR SIGNIFICANCE

UNDERSTANDING TYPICAL ABNORMALITIES HELPS IN QUICK DIAGNOSIS AND MANAGEMENT.

ARRHYTHMIAS

- ATRIAL FIBRILLATION: IRREGULARLY IRREGULAR RHYTHM, NO DISCERNIBLE P WAVES.
- VENTRICULAR TACHYCARDIA: WIDE QRS, FAST RATE, REGULAR RHYTHM.
- SUPRAVENTRICULAR TACHYCARDIA (SVT): NARROW QRS, RAPID RATE, OFTEN WITH P WAVES HIDDEN.

ISCHEMIC CHANGES

- ST ELEVATION: INDICATES ACUTE MYOCARDIAL INFARCTION.
- ST DEPRESSION: SUGGESTS ISCHEMIA.
- INVERTED T WAVES: MAY REFLECT ISCHEMIA OR PREVIOUS INFARCT.

CONDUCTION BLOCKS

- FIRST-DEGREE AV BLOCK: PROLONGED PR INTERVAL.
- SECOND-DEGREE AV BLOCK: INTERMITTENT DROPPED BEATS.
- THIRD-DEGREE (COMPLETE) BLOCK: NO ASSOCIATION BETWEEN P WAVES AND QRS COMPLEXES.

HYPERTROPHY AND ENLARGEMENT

- LEFT VENTRICULAR HYPERTROPHY (LVH): INCREASED QRS VOLTAGE, LEFT AXIS DEVIATION.

- RIGHT VENTRICULAR HYPERTROPHY (RVH): RIGHT AXIS DEVIATION, DOMINANT R WAVE IN V1.
