GRADUATES OF SEJPME-1 ARE BETTER EQUIPPED TO HANDLE LEADERSHIP ROLES THAT REQUIRE A BROAD PERSPECTIVE ON NATIONAL SECURITY AND MILITARY STRATEGY. THE COURSE EMPHASIZES CRITICAL THINKING, DECISION-MAKING, AND PROBLEM-SOLVING SKILLS NECESSARY AT SENIOR LEVELS.

### PROMOTING INTEROPERABILITY

IN MODERN MILITARY OPERATIONS, INTEROPERABILITY AMONG BRANCHES IS VITAL. THIS PROGRAM HELPS SENIOR ENLISTED PERSONNEL DEVELOP A SHARED UNDERSTANDING OF JOINT TACTICS, TECHNIQUES, AND PROCEDURES (TTPs), FACILITATING SEAMLESS INTEGRATION DURING JOINT MISSIONS.

- **EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES AND CYBER WARFARE:** UNDERSTANDING CUTTING-EDGE TECHNOLOGY IMPACTS ON JOINT OPERATIONS.
- **CULTURAL AND REGIONAL AWARENESS:** RECOGNIZING THE IMPORTANCE OF CULTURAL COMPETENCE IN JOINT AND COMBINED OPERATIONS.

- RECOMMENDATION FROM COMMANDING OFFICERS OR SUPERVISORS
- COMPLETION OF PREREQUISITE COURSES OR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS
- ABILITY TO COMMIT TO THE DURATION OF THE PROGRAM, INCLUDING ONLINE AND IN-RESIDENCE COMPONENTS

## APPLICATION PROCESS

THE APPLICATION PROCESS GENERALLY INVOLVES:

1. SUBMITTING AN ONLINE APPLICATION THROUGH OFFICIAL MILITARY EDUCATION PORTALS
2. PROVIDING CAREER AND LEADERSHIP DOCUMENTATION
3. SECURING ENDORSEMENTS FROM CURRENT SUPERVISORS
4. PARTICIPATING IN INTERVIEWS OR ASSESSMENTS AS REQUIRED

## ROLE OF SENIOR ENLISTED JOINT PME 1 IN MILITARY OPERATIONS

SENIOR ENLISTED JOINT PME 1 PLAYS A PIVOTAL ROLE IN SHAPING MILITARY READINESS AND OPERATIONAL SUCCESS. ENLISTED LEADERS WHO HAVE COMPLETED THIS PROGRAM ARE BETTER PREPARED TO:

1. SERVE AS LIAISONS BETWEEN OFFICERS AND ENLISTED PERSONNEL IN JOINT COMMANDS
2. IMPLEMENT AND ADVOCATE FOR JOINT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES
3. CONTRIBUTE TO STRATEGIC PLANNING AND DECISION-MAKING PROCESSES
4. MENTOR JUNIOR ENLISTED PERSONNEL IN JOINT ENVIRONMENTS
5. ENSURE EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION ACROSS BRANCHES DURING COMPLEX OPERATIONS

FURTHERMORE, AS MILITARY OPERATIONS INCREASINGLY INVOLVE MULTI-DOMAIN AND MULTI-NATIONAL EFFORTS, THE IMPORTANCE OF WELL-EDUCATED SENIOR ENLISTED PERSONNEL IN JOINT ENVIRONMENTS CANNOT BE OVERSTATED.

## ARE THERE ANY PREREQUISITES OR PRIOR EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ENROLLING IN SEJPME PHASE 1?

YES, CANDIDATES TYPICALLY NEED TO BE SENIOR NCOs WITH RELEVANT EXPERIENCE OR IN ROLES REQUIRING JOINT KNOWLEDGE, AND OFTEN MUST COMPLETE CERTAIN PROFESSIONAL MILITARY EDUCATION COURSES OR HAVE EQUIVALENT MILITARY EXPERIENCE BEFORE ENROLLING.

THE COURSE FOCUSES ON DEVELOPING SENIOR ENLISTED LEADERS' CAPACITY TO CONTRIBUTE EFFECTIVELY TO JOINT PLANNING, DECISION-MAKING, AND OPERATIONAL EXECUTION, EMPHASIZING THE IMPORTANCE OF COLLABORATION AND STRATEGIC VISION.

- ENHANCE THEIR ABILITY TO LEAD AND ADVISE IN JOINT ENVIRONMENTS
- FOSTER A STRATEGIC MINDSET ALIGNED WITH NATIONAL SECURITY OBJECTIVES
- PROMOTE UNDERSTANDING OF JOINT PLANNING, COMMAND AND CONTROL, AND INTEROPERABILITY
- PREPARE PERSONNEL FOR JOINT DUTY ASSIGNMENTS, INCLUDING JOINT STAFF, COMBATANT COMMANDS, AND MULTINATIONAL OPERATIONS

THE COURSE EMPHASIZES LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT, CRITICAL THINKING, AND AN UNDERSTANDING OF THE BROADER STRATEGIC CONTEXT WITHIN WHICH MILITARY OPERATIONS OCCUR.

- REFRESH YOUR UNDERSTANDING OF BASIC JOINT DOCTRINE, INCLUDING JOINT PUBLICATION (JP) 1, JP 3-0, AND JP 5-0.
- FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH RECENT JOINT OPERATIONS AND CASE STUDIES.
- UNDERSTAND THE STRUCTURE AND FUNCTIONS OF COMBATANT COMMANDS.

### 2. ENGAGE IN SELF-DIRECTED LEARNING
