Balancing historical nuance with passion for cinematic narratives, *Writing History with Lightning* confronts how movies about nineteenth-century America influence the ways in which mass audiences remember, understand, and envision the nation's past. In these twenty-six essays—divided by the editors into sections on topics like frontiers, slavery, the Civil War, the Lost Cause, and the West—notable historians engage with films and the historical events they ostensibly depict. Instead of just separating fact from fiction, the essays contemplate the extent to which movies generate and promulgate collective memories of American history. Along with new takes on familiar classics like *Young Mr. Lincoln* and *They Died with Their Boots On*, the volume covers several films released in recent years, including *The Revenant*, *12 Years a Slave*, *The Birth of a Nation*, *Free State of Jones*, and *The Hateful Eight*. The authors address Hollywood epics like *The Alamo* and *Amistad*, arguing that these movies flatten the historical record to promote nationalist visions. The contributors also examine overlooked films like *Hester Street* and *Daughters of the Dust*, considering their portraits of marginalized communities as transformative perspectives on American culture. By surveying films about nineteenth-century America, *Writing History with Lightning* analyzes how movies create popular understandings of American history and why those interpretations change over time.

Northern networks of merit to slavery.
