of the feminine and the complex cultural and eco wastelands, this post-Jungian inquiry remythologizes notions of wholeness, amplifies feminist revisions of Joseph Campbell's "hero's" journey, and provides transdisciplinary best practices in support of personal individuation, cultural revitalization, and ecological healing.

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
