WHILE FREE PDFs ARE INVALUABLE, USERS SHOULD BE AWARE OF POTENTIAL LIMITATIONS:

- OUTDATED INFORMATION: ENSURE THE PDFs ARE RECENT AND REFLECT CURRENT BEST PRACTICES.
- QUALITY VARIABILITY: NOT ALL PDFs ARE PEER-REVIEWED; PRIORITIZE AUTHORITATIVE SOURCES.
- ACCESSIBILITY: SOME PDFs MAY REQUIRE SPECIFIC SOFTWARE OR TOOLS TO OPEN.
