- EVOLVING EVIDENCE: NEW RESEARCH CAN ALTER SAFETY PROFILES, MAKING REGULAR UPDATES ESSENTIAL.
- INDIVIDUALIZED CARE: CATEGORIZATION CANNOT REPLACE PERSONALIZED MEDICAL ADVICE.
