By advancing this complementary sacred partnership, Sera Khandro carved a place for herself as a female virtuoso in the male-dominated sphere of early twentieth-century Tibetan religion.

Exploring key examples in popular culture ranging from Peter Sellers' portrayal of Hrundi Bakshi in the 1968 film *The Party* to contemporary representations such as Apu from *The Simpsons* and characters in *Harold and Kumar Go to White Castle*, Shilpa S.
