Going far beyond D&D, this heavily illustrated tome covers more than three hundred different RPGs that have been published in the last five decades. *Monsters, Aliens, and Holes in the Ground* features (among other things) bunnies, ghostbusters, soap operas, criminal bears, space monsters, political intrigue, vampires, romance, and, of course, some dungeons and dragons. In a decade-by-decade breakdown, Horvath chronicles how RPGs have evolved in the time between their inception and the present day, offering a deep and gratifying glimpse into a hobby that has changed the way we think about games and play.
