1. NEGLECTING ACADEMIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- DEPEND SOLELY ON LAST-MINUTE CRAMMING FOR EXAMS
- DISREGARD THE IMPORTANCE OF INTERNSHIPS AND RESEARCH OPPORTUNITIES

TIPS TO AVOID ACADEMIC PITFALLS

1. MAINTAIN A DISCIPLINED STUDY SCHEDULE FROM THE BEGINNING OF THE SEMESTER.

2. IGNORING HEALTH AND WELL-BEING

HOW TO PRIORITIZE HEALTH

1. ESTABLISH A ROUTINE THAT INCLUDES SUFFICIENT SLEEP AND BREAKS.
2. ENGAGE IN SPORTS, YOGA, OR OTHER PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES AVAILABLE ON CAMPUS.
3. PRACTICE MINDFULNESS AND STRESS MANAGEMENT TECHNIQUES.
4. MAINTAIN A BALANCED DIET AND STAY HYDRATED.
5. SEEK SUPPORT FROM COUNSELING SERVICES IF FEELING OVERWHELMED.

3. GETTING INVOLVED IN NEGATIVE PEER INFLUENCE

- GET DISTRACTED BY EXCESSIVE PARTYING OR SOCIALIZING AT THE COST OF ACADEMICS

- ENGAGE IN SUBSTANCE ABUSE OR RISKY BEHAVIORS
- FOLLOW PEERS BLINDLY WITHOUT EVALUATING CONSEQUENCES

BUILDING A POSITIVE PEER NETWORK

1. SURROUND YOURSELF WITH MOTIVATED AND GOAL-ORIENTED FRIENDS.
2. PARTICIPATE IN CLUBS, SOCIETIES, AND ACADEMIC GROUPS TO FOSTER CONSTRUCTIVE RELATIONSHIPS.
3. SHARE KNOWLEDGE AND COLLABORATE ON PROJECTS FOR MUTUAL BENEFIT.
4. DISTANCE YOURSELF FROM NEGATIVE INFLUENCES OR TOXIC ENVIRONMENTS.

4. UNDERESTIMATING THE VALUE OF SOFT SKILLS AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

BEYOND ACADEMICS: HOLISTIC DEVELOPMENT

WHAT NOT TO DO

- FOCUS SOLELY ON ACADEMICS WITHOUT PARTICIPATING IN CLUBS, SPORTS, OR CULTURAL EVENTS
- NEGLECT DEVELOPING COMMUNICATION AND INTERPERSONAL SKILLS
- IGNORE LEADERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES OR VOLUNTEERING ACTIVITIES
- UNDERESTIMATE THE IMPORTANCE OF NETWORKING AND INDUSTRY INTERACTIONS

MAXIMIZING EXTRACURRICULAR ENGAGEMENT

1. JOIN STUDENT CLUBS RELATED TO YOUR INTERESTS OR CAREER GOALS.
2. PARTICIPATE IN HACKATHONS, TECHNICAL FESTIVALS, AND CULTURAL EVENTS.
3. DEVELOP SOFT SKILLS THROUGH WORKSHOPS, SEMINARS, AND GROUP PROJECTS.
4. TAKE ON LEADERSHIP ROLES TO BUILD CONFIDENCE AND ORGANIZATIONAL SKILLS.

5. NETWORK WITH ALUMNI AND INDUSTRY PROFESSIONALS DURING CAMPUS VISITS AND EVENTS.

5. IGNORING ETHICAL CONDUCT AND CAMPUS RULES

THE SIGNIFICANCE OF INTEGRITY AT IIT

- ENGAGE IN THEFT, VANDALISM, OR ANY FORM OF MISCONDUCT
- DISREGARD HOSTEL OR CAMPUS REGULATIONS
- PARTICIPATE IN ACTIVITIES THAT HARM THE REPUTATION OF THE INSTITUTE

PRACTICING ETHICAL BEHAVIOR

1. MAINTAIN HONESTY IN ALL ACADEMIC PURSUITS.
2. RESPECT FELLOW STUDENTS, FACULTY, AND STAFF.
3. FOLLOW CAMPUS GUIDELINES REGARDING CONDUCT, SAFETY, AND CLEANLINESS.
4. REPORT UNETHICAL BEHAVIOR RESPONSIBLY.
5. LEAD BY EXAMPLE AND PROMOTE A CULTURE OF INTEGRITY.

WHAT MISTAKES SHOULD I STEER CLEAR OF REGARDING FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT AT IIT?

AVOID UNNECESSARY EXPENSES, IMPULSIVE SPENDING, AND NEGLECTING BUDGETING. MANAGING YOUR FINANCES WISELY HELPS

PREVENT STRESS AND ENSURES RESOURCES LAST THROUGH THE SEMESTER.

TIPS TO AVOID THIS MISTAKE

- USE PLANNERS OR DIGITAL APPS TO ORGANIZE YOUR TASKS.
- PRIORITIZE TASKS BASED ON DEADLINES AND IMPORTANCE.
- ALLOCATE SPECIFIC TIME SLOTS FOR STUDIES, RECREATION, AND REST.
- LEARN TO SAY NO TO ACTIVITIES THAT OVEREXTEND YOUR BANDWIDTH.

2. IGNORING THE IMPORTANCE OF SOFT SKILLS AND NETWORKING

THE OVERLOOKED ASPECT OF IIT LIFE

WHAT NOT TO DO

- DO NOT ISOLATE YOURSELF FROM PEERS AND FACULTY.
- AVOID NEGLECTING OPPORTUNITIES TO PARTICIPATE IN CLUBS, SEMINARS, OR WORKSHOPS.
- REFRAIN FROM UNDERVALUING THE IMPORTANCE OF EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION.

WHY SOFT SKILLS MATTER

- THEY ENHANCE YOUR ABILITY TO COLLABORATE ON PROJECTS.
- OPEN DOORS TO INTERNSHIPS, RESEARCH OPPORTUNITIES, AND INDUSTRY CONNECTIONS.
- IMPROVE YOUR CONFIDENCE AND LEADERSHIP QUALITIES.

HOW TO CULTIVATE SOFT SKILLS

- ENGAGE ACTIVELY IN STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS AND EVENTS.
- PRACTICE PUBLIC SPEAKING AND PRESENTATION SKILLS.
- SEEK MENTORSHIP AND FEEDBACK FROM SENIORS AND PROFESSORS.
- ATTEND WORKSHOPS ON COMMUNICATION AND LEADERSHIP.

3. FALLING INTO THE TRAP OF CRAMMING AND LAST-MINUTE STUDYING

THE COMMON MISTAKE

MANY STUDENTS ADOPT A HABIT OF CRAMMING BEFORE EXAMS, WHICH HAMPERS TRUE UNDERSTANDING AND LONG-TERM RETENTION OF CONCEPTS. THIS APPROACH OFTEN LEADS TO POOR ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE AND INCREASED STRESS DURING EXAMS.

WHAT NOT TO DO

- AVOID DELAYING STUDYING UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE.
- DO NOT RELY SOLELY ON ROTE MEMORIZATION WITHOUT GRASPING FUNDAMENTALS.
- REFRAIN FROM SKIPPING REGULAR REVISION OF TOPICS.

NEGATIVE OUTCOMES

- HIGHER ANXIETY LEVELS DURING EXAMS.
- LOWER RETENTION AND APPLICATION ABILITY.
- INCREASED LIKELIHOOD OF ACADEMIC FAILURE.

EFFECTIVE STUDY STRATEGIES

- ADOPT A CONSISTENT STUDY SCHEDULE THROUGHOUT THE SEMESTER.
- BREAK DOWN SYLLABUS INTO MANAGEABLE SECTIONS.
- USE ACTIVE LEARNING TECHNIQUES LIKE PROBLEM-SOLVING AND DISCUSSIONS.
- REGULARLY REVISE TOPICS TO REINFORCE UNDERSTANDING.

4. DISREGARDING HEALTH AND WELL-BEING

THE HIDDEN COST OF STUDENT LIFE

- DO NOT SKIP MEALS, EXERCISE, OR SLEEP IN PURSUIT OF ACADEMIC GOALS.
- REFRAIN FROM OVERUSE OF SUBSTANCES LIKE CAFFEINE OR ENERGY DRINKS TO STAY AWAKE.

CONSEQUENCES OF POOR HEALTH HABITS

- REDUCED CONCENTRATION AND COGNITIVE FUNCTION.
- INCREASED SUSCEPTIBILITY TO ILLNESSES.
- EMOTIONAL INSTABILITY AND MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES LIKE ANXIETY AND DEPRESSION.
- LONG-TERM HEALTH PROBLEMS.

TIPS TO MAINTAIN WELL-BEING

- MAINTAIN A BALANCED DIET AND STAY HYDRATED.
- INCORPORATE REGULAR PHYSICAL ACTIVITY OR SPORTS.
- ENSURE ADEQUATE SLEEP AND REST PERIODS.
- PRACTICE MINDFULNESS, MEDITATION, OR YOGA TO MANAGE STRESS.
- SEEK COUNSELING OR SUPPORT SERVICES IF NEEDED.

5. UNDERESTIMATING THE VALUE OF PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE AND INTERNSHIPS

WHY EXPERIENCE MATTERS

- REDUCED COMPETITIVENESS IN THE JOB MARKET.
- MISSED OPPORTUNITIES FOR MENTORSHIP AND NETWORKING.

HOW TO GAIN PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE

- START APPLYING FOR INTERNSHIPS EARLY, EVEN DURING FRESHMAN OR SOPHOMORE YEARS.
- PARTICIPATE IN HACKATHONS, CODING COMPETITIONS, OR RESEARCH PROJECTS.
- COLLABORATE WITH FACULTY ON INNOVATIVE RESEARCH.
- ATTEND INDUSTRY SEMINARS AND WORKSHOPS.

five point someone what not to do at iit: Knowledge-Power/Resistance Vinod Kumar Rawat, 2014-10-22 Schools, Colleges, Universities, and Educational institutes, that is, knowledge factories, apart from producing self-governing citizens, and skilled docile workers, function as minute social observatories that indirectly monitor their families. Michel Foucault delineates power in terms of Pastoral (church and salvation), Sovereign (visible and verifiable), Disciplinary (invisible and unverifiable), Bio-power (reproduction and individualization), Psychiatric (normal and abnormal), and Governmentality (sovereignty, discipline, and government). By applying Foucaults theory, the research investigated the relevance of the Francis Bacons popular dictum, Knowledge is Power, and Dr. B. R. Ambedkars final words, Educate, Agitate, Organize. The insights of the research may benefit the seekers and disseminators of knowledge in understanding the subtle operative modes of the government-capitalist nexus and in advocating appropriate resistance against the pathologies of power.
