The expected final book was then split into three volumes: *The Gathering Storm*, *Towers of Midnight*, and *A Memory of Light*. The books would be published a year apart with the first volume, *The Gathering Storm*, published on October 27, 2009; a week earlier than originally announced. Upon its release, it immediately rose to the No. 1 position on the The New York Times hardcover fiction Best Seller list, making it the fifth consecutive Wheel of Time book to achieve this feat. The three books will together encompass what can be considered Jordan's final vision of the series. In the foreword, Sanderson states that they can be thought of as the three volumes of *A Memory of Light* or as the final three books of The Wheel of Time. Both are correct.
