LEE CONTINUES TO WORK ON TOLKIEN-RELATED PROJECTS, INCLUDING EXHIBITIONS AND SPECIAL EDITIONS OF TOLKIEN'S WORKS. HIS INVOLVEMENT IN PROJECTS LIKE THE NATURE OF MIDDLE-EARTH (A COMPANION VOLUME) EMPHASIZES HIS ONGOING COMMITMENT TO EXPLORING AND VISUALIZING TOLKIEN'S MYTHOLOGY.

AS DIGITAL MEDIA EVOLVE, LEE'S TRADITIONAL WATERCOLOR TECHNIQUES REMAIN A BENCHMARK FOR QUALITY AND AUTHENTICITY, INSPIRING FUTURE GENERATIONS OF ILLUSTRATORS AND TOLKIEN ENTHUSIASTS.
