GEOGRAPHICALLY, TAHITI LIES APPROXIMATELY 4,400 KILOMETERS (2,700 MILES) SOUTH OF HAWAII AND ABOUT 7,900 KILOMETERS (4,900 MILES) SOUTHWEST OF CALIFORNIA, POSITIONING IT AS A CENTRAL HUB IN THE POLYNESIAN TRIANGLE.

PHYSICAL GEOGRAPHY AND TOPOGRAPHY

- TAHITI'S LANDSCAPE: CHARACTERIZED BY A MOUNTAINOUS INTERIOR WITH PEAKS EXCEEDING 2,300 METERS (7,550 FEET), LUSH VALLEYS, AND EXTENSIVE COASTAL PLAINS. THE ISLAND'S VOLCANIC ORIGINS ARE EVIDENT IN ITS RUGGED TERRAIN, WATERFALLS, AND DENSE RAINFORESTS.
