The appeal of horror literature to young adults cannot be denied or ignored, and in *Presenting Young Adult Horror Fiction*, the first genre study in the Twayne Young Adult Authors Series, Cosette Kies concentrates on teenage interest in the field. Separate chapters explore the appeal of satanism for young adults in novels such as *The Exorcist* and *Rosemary's Baby*, and there is an irreverent look at a recent development in horror writing--splatterpunk. *Presenting Young Adult Horror Fiction* is a welcome addition for all those interested in horror literature and will also provide much-needed information for librarians, teachers, and parents who want to understand why young adults love horror literature.
