THE HAUNTED PERSONA

THE NOVEL'S TITLE AND OVERARCHING MOOD EVOKE THE IDEA OF BEING HAUNTED—BY PAST SINS, SOCIETAL GUILT, OR PERSONAL TRAUMA. MANY CHARACTERS GRAPPLE WITH THEIR OWN DEMONS, AND THE NARRATIVE SUGGESTS THAT EVERYONE CARRIES A SHADOW, WHICH CAN SURFACE IN DESTRUCTIVE WAYS.

THIS HAUNTING IS NOT JUST METAPHORICAL; PALAHNIUK EMPLOYS VISCERAL IMAGERY AND UNSETTLING SCENARIOS TO EVOKE A SENSE OF UNEASE. THE NOVEL'S TONE IS INTENTIONALLY DISCONCERTING, FORCING READERS TO CONFRONT THEIR OWN FEARS AND MORAL AMBIGUITIES.

NARRATIVE STYLE AND LITERARY TECHNIQUES

THE USE OF SHOCK AND SURREALISM

THE CONTROVERSY AND CRITICAL RECEPTION

WHY HAUNTED IS CONSIDERED A "HAUNTED" BOOK

THE NOVEL'S REPUTATION AS A "HAUNTED" PIECE STEMS FROM SEVERAL FACTORS:
