ONE OF THE CHALLENGES IN LONG ISLAND'S CARTOGRAPHY IS REPRESENTING THE DENSELY POPULATED URBAN AREAS VERSUS RURAL ZONES. THE MAP MUST BALANCE DETAIL WITH CLARITY, ESPECIALLY IN REGIONS WHERE SUBURBAN SPRAWL ENCROACHES ON NATURAL RESERVES.
