He confided to one correspondent that he had never been more at peace or more happy. The eight books of *The Letters of George Santayana* bring together over 3,000 letters, many of which have been discovered in the fifty years since Santayana's death. Letters in Book Seven are written to such correspondents as his friend and protégée Daniel Cory, his financial manager and heir George Sturgis, and the American poet Robert Lowell. The correspondence with Lowell--which began when the younger writer sent Santayana a copy of his Pulitzer Prize-winning *Lord Weary's Castle*--signals an important new friendship, which became a source of affection and intellectual engagement in Santayana's final years.
