The film narratives under examination include *Crouching Tiger, Hidden Dragon* (directed by Ang Lee); *Hero* (Zhang Yimou); *House of the Flying Daggers* (Zhang Yimou); *Seven Swords* (Tsui Hark); *The Promise* (Chen Kaige); *The Banquet* (Feng Xiaogang); and *Curse of the Golden Flower* (Zhang Yimou). Chen also touches upon the plots of two of the earliest award-winning Chinese martial arts films, *A Touch of Zen* and *Legend of the Mountain*, both directed by King Hu.
