Pearl Harbor Angriff ist ein entscheidendes Ereignis in der Geschichte des Zweiten Weltkriegs, das am 7. Dezember 1941 stattfand. Der Überfall auf Pearl Harbor, eine militärische Basis der United States Navy auf Hawaii, führte zu einem dramatischen Wandel in der geopolitischen Landschaft und war der Auslöser für den Eintritt der Vereinigten Staaten in den Krieg. - Die Japaner setzten auf Überraschung und führten intensive Luftangriffe durch, die die meisten Schiffe und Flugzeuge der US Navy zerstören sollten.

Der Angriff selbst

- Am Morgen des 7. Dezember 1941, gegen 7:48 Uhr, starteten die japanischen Flugzeuge ihren Angriff auf Pearl Harbor.
- Über 350 japanische Flugzeuge, darunter Torpedobomber und Jagdflugzeuge, griffen die Basis an.
- Die ersten Angriffe konzentrierten sich auf die Schiffe der US Navy, die im Hafen lagen, sowie auf die Luftwaffe, die auf dem Boden stationiert war.

Die Folgen des Angriffs

- Der Angriff dauerte etwa zwei Stunden und hinterließ verheerende Schäden.
- Insgesamt wurden 18 Schiffe der US Navy versenkt oder beschädigt und über 200 Flugzeuge zerstört.
- Mehr als 2.400 Amerikaner verloren
