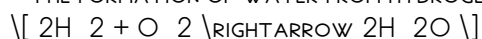
1. SYNTHESIS REACTIONS

SYNTHESIS REACTIONS, ALSO KNOWN AS COMBINATION REACTIONS, OCCUR WHEN TWO OR MORE REACTANTS COMBINE TO FORM A SINGLE PRODUCT. THIS TYPE OF REACTION CAN BE REPRESENTED BY THE GENERAL EQUATION:

2. DECOMPOSITION REACTIONS

DECOMPOSITION REACTIONS INVOLVE THE BREAKDOWN OF A SINGLE COMPOUND INTO TWO OR MORE SIMPLER SUBSTANCES. THIS CAN BE REPRESENTED BY THE GENERAL EQUATION:



EXAMPLE:

- THE DECOMPOSITION OF HYDROGEN PEROXIDE INTO WATER AND OXYGEN:



3. SINGLE REPLACEMENT REACTIONS

IN SINGLE REPLACEMENT REACTIONS, ONE ELEMENT REPLACES ANOTHER ELEMENT IN A COMPOUND. THE GENERAL FORM OF THIS REACTION IS:

- ZINC REPLACING COPPER IN COPPER(II) SULFATE:



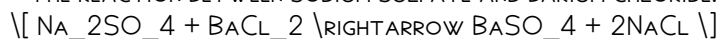
4. DOUBLE REPLACEMENT REACTIONS

DOUBLE REPLACEMENT REACTIONS INVOLVE THE EXCHANGE OF IONS BETWEEN TWO COMPOUNDS, RESULTING IN THE FORMATION OF TWO NEW COMPOUNDS. THE GENERAL EQUATION IS:

- THE REACTION BETWEEN SODIUM SULFATE AND BARIUM CHLORIDE:



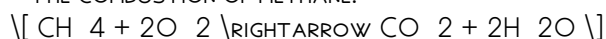
5. COMBUSTION REACTIONS

COMBUSTION REACTIONS OCCUR WHEN A SUBSTANCE (USUALLY A HYDROCARBON) REACTS WITH OXYGEN TO PRODUCE CARBON DIOXIDE, WATER, AND ENERGY IN THE FORM OF HEAT AND LIGHT. THE GENERAL EQUATION CAN BE REPRESENTED AS:



EXAMPLE:

- THE COMBUSTION OF METHANE:



6. REDOX REACTIONS

REDOX (REDUCTION-OXIDATION) REACTIONS INVOLVE THE TRANSFER OF ELECTRONS BETWEEN TWO SPECIES, RESULTING IN CHANGES IN OXIDATION STATES. THESE REACTIONS CAN BE CLASSIFIED INTO TWO MAIN PROCESSES:

- REDUCTION: GAIN OF ELECTRONS
- OXIDATION: LOSS OF ELECTRONS

- THE REACTION BETWEEN IRON(III) OXIDE AND ALUMINUM:



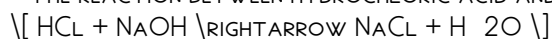
7. ACID-BASE REACTIONS

ACID-BASE REACTIONS INVOLVE THE TRANSFER OF PROTONS (H^+ IONS) BETWEEN AN ACID AND A BASE. THE GENERAL EQUATION FOR AN ACID-BASE REACTION CAN BE REPRESENTED AS:
