This code can be referred to rebuilt and extended metro engineering and those whose the highest running speed exceeds 100km/h, as well as urban rail transit of other types. 1.0.3 Metro engineering design must comply with general urban planning and urban rail transit network planning approved by competent governmental authorities. 1.0.4 Under the precondition that metro engineering has satisfied requirement of system safety, function and environment, aerial defence requirement can be determined by competent municipal authorities according to concrete conditions. 1.0.5 Design period of metro engineering shall be divided into three stages, such as preliminary stage, short-term stage and long-term stage.
