Specifically, *extensivism* believes that man was created in the image of God with otherwise choice; God's salvation plan involves an all-inclusive unconditional offer of salvation to every person, reception of which is conditioned upon grace-enabled faith rather than Calvinism's exclusive plan of a limited actual offer of salvation to only the unconditionally elected. Generally, it replaces the term *non-Calvinism*. These are the five primary objectives of the book: First, my considerations would result in a deeper understanding of God.
